Coaches Code of Conduct

- 1. Maintain consistent communication with your parents throughout the season concerning practice scheduling, league events, and potential travel arrangements.
- 2. Remember that children are involved in sports for their enjoyment, not yours.
- 3. Respect all decisions made by referees, officials, and league volunteers. Any formal questions or concerns prior to or after a game shall be directed to the Lassen Youth Soccer (LYS) board.
- 4. If one of your players is injured, it is your responsibility to prioritize their safety even if they are willing to continue playing. Whenever a head injury is suspected, always follow the appropriate concussion protocol.
- 5. **DO NOT** express a condescending, explicit, or aggressive attitude at any time. This translates to anyone (friends, family, or spectators) that are present to watch your team play. Not only are you the model of sportsmanship for your team, but you are responsible for maintaining positive commentary from your side of the field.
